<b>Worry-Free Oxygen Absorber Sizes</b>	
1/2 PINT (237ml)	50cc
PINT (473ml)	100cc
QUART (946ml)	300cc
GALLON (3.8L)	500cc*
5 GALLONS (18.9L)	2500cc*

\* Container must be full
