Last fall some lot owners decided that starting January 2014, they would each pay \$40 per year to cover the cost of the electricity to power the gate and the light at the gate.

Prior to this the \$24 that you were adding to your Road Fee payments each year was not fully covering the electric bill for the gate and the light. I have been taking the shortfall from the Alapine Village Road Fund. These owners want all of the money collected for Road Fees to go to road maintenance.

I am asking each of you to increase your payment for electricity at the gate by also paying \$40 for 2014. If you have already paid some gate electric money, that is reflected in the attached reminder.

Over is an accounting for 2014 so far of electric bills and payments.

Last fall I interviewed people to hire to do the road maintenance work at Alapine.

I selected Jack Brewer from Lyerly because they suggested a material we have not used before to try on the hills and on Artha Avenue (the road in front of Emily's). I hoped we would be able to test it out this past winter to see if it is as promising as they suggest.

We scheduled the work for October 2013, but were unable to do the job because of the rain. I too was disappointed not to be able to "get this off my list" last fall.

I have been in touch with my contact at Jack Brewer and we are on their list for as soon as they can get to us.

I have your notification that you are withholding road fee payments. However, I hope you will bring your payments up to date. The more money there is in the fund, the more of the roads will be improved when they come to do the work.
